What will it clean

Cleaner No1 is a gentle but effective cleaner containing a degreaser to deep clean your tiles. This is ideal to clean and remove built up dirt and grease on all your ceramic and porcelain tiles. Cleaner No1 also effectively cleans PVC and Vinyl floors without damaging the surface.

Where to use

Cleaner No1 is perfect for use in kitchens, hallways or bathrooms where you have dirty tiles and grout.

How to Use

Dilute the cleaner with water to dilution rate above and apply cleaner to the surface. Leave product for 5 minutes - NB do not allow to dry on surface. Scrub the area with The Tile Master or stiff brush. Clean away dirty water using a clean mop. Repeat if required of very dirty surfaces. For daily maintenance, dilute 2 capfuls of cleaner no 1 into a bucket of warm water. Wash the floor and allow to dry. Does not require rinsing.

Coverage

Dilution rates per 1 litre

Deep cleaning and degreasing - 1:4 - 15m²

Tile and grout refresh - 1:12 - 45m²

Maintenance clean - 1:200 (1 cap to 5ltr of water, polished surfaces may require a dry buff)

Important

On waxed or polished surfaces i.e polished porcelain, a dry buff may be required with a soft cloth or towel.
